

**TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY
BYLAW 16-1061**

**BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE WATER AND SEWER UTILITY SYSTEMS BYLAW 08-950
OF THE TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

WHEREAS Pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act* R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26 as amended, respecting public utilities, Council of the Town of Turner Valley in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter called the "Council") has adopted the Water and Sewer Utility Systems Bylaw 08-950.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Turner Valley is a shareholder of Sheep River Regional Utility Corp., and has entered into an agreement with Sheep River Regional Utility Corp to supply potable water to the Town of Turner Valley for local distribution by the Town to customers.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to amend Bylaw 08-950 Water Utility and Sewer Service Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Turner Valley enacts that the Water Utility and Sewer Service Bylaw 08-950 be amended as follows:

By deleting SECTION 1 – GENERAL 1.1 Town's Water Supply. (a)

1.1 Town's Water Supply by deleting the following clause

- (a) The Town having constructed, operated and maintained a water system as a public utility shall continue, insofar as there is sufficient plant capacity and supply of potable water, to supply potable water, upon such terms, charges and costs as Council considers advisable to any dwelling unit, Commercial or Industrial premises, or other property owner within the municipality situated along any water main, upon being so requested in writing by the owner of the dwelling unit, Commercial or Industrial Premises, industry or building. The Town undertakes, subject to Section 34(1) of the Act, as amended or any legislation passed in amendment to or substitution therefore, to supply water to the owner's water system at the property line of the street or the boundary of an Easement granted to the Town for its water system.

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By inserting the following amendment:

1.1 Town's Water Supply

- (a) The Town having constructed, operated and maintained a water distribution system as a public utility shall continue to own and operate the water distribution system, including distribution mains, service connections, valves, fittings, hydrants, meters, backflow prevention devices and all other equipment and machinery operated and maintained by the Town for the purpose of delivering potable water to customers. Upon such terms, charges and costs as Council considers advisable to any dwelling unit, Commercial or Industrial premises, or other property owner within the municipality situated along any water main, upon being so requested in writing by the owner of the dwelling unit, Commercial or Industrial Premises, industry or building. The Town undertakes, subject to Section 34(1) of the Act, as amended or any legislation passed in amendment to or substitution therefore, to supply water to the owner's water system at the property line of the street or the boundary of an Easement granted to the Town for its water system.

By Inserting the following additional clauses:

1.1 Town's Water Supply

- (b) The Town as a forty five percent (45%) shareholder of the Sheep River Regional Utility Corp., and shall obtain its potable water supply from the Sheep River Regional Utility Corp. for local distribution.
- (c) The Town does not guarantee or warrant the continuous supply of potable water and the Town reserves the right to change the operating pressure, restrict the availability of water or to disconnect water, in whole or in part, with or without notice, in accordance with this bylaw.
- (d) Customers depending upon a continuous and uninterrupted supply or pressure of water or who require or have processes or equipment that require particularly clear or pure water shall provide such facilities, as they are considered necessary, to ensure a continuous and uninterrupted supply, pressure or quality of water required for this use, subject to the terms of this bylaw. The Town assumes no responsibility for the same.

And by amending numbering 1.1 (b) to 1.1 (e)


By amending Section 13 – Definition "Water Utility" by removing any reference to infrastructure located upstream of the Town owned water distribution system. Specifically, references to "water wells, water treatment plants, water reservoirs, feeder and feeder mains as these assets have been transferred to Sheep River Regional Utility Corp.

"Water Utility" means that system of distribution mains, service connections, valves, fittings, hydrants, meters, backflow prevention devices and all other equipment and machinery of whatever kind owned and operated by the Town for the purpose of delivering potable water to Customers.


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THIS BYLAW comes into effect on the date of its **THIRD** and **FINAL READING**.
