

**TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY
BYLAW #16-1057**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TURNER VALLEY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
FOR THE IMPOSITION OF TAX PENALTIES.**

PURSUANT to Sections 344 and 345 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, Council of the Town of Turner Valley in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts the following:

1. That all current taxes remaining unpaid after June 30th in the year they are levied shall be charged a penalty of **SIX (6%) PERCENT**.
2. That all current taxes remaining unpaid after September 30th, in the year they are levied shall be charged a penalty of **SIX (6%) PERCENT**.
3. If after the last day of December in any year, any taxes which become due and payable in that year remain unpaid, there shall be added thereto by way of a penalty, an amount of **TWELVE (12%) PERCENT** on the first day of January of the following year and each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.


That Bylaw 15-1045 is hereby rescinded

This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the date of the third and final reading.


